Effective September 3, 2013, the three qualifying scores required to be awarded an AKC herding title may be earned under at least two different judges on the same course and livestock rather than three different judges.

HANDLERS MEETING: There will be a handlers meeting at the beginning of each class.

LUNCH BREAK will be scheduled at the judge's discretion.

ENTRIES open Tuesday, February 13, 2018 at 8:00 AM. **NO HAND DELIVERED ENTRIES ACCEPTED.** Entries close Saturday, March 17, 2018 at 5:00 PM.

- A separate form must be submitted for each dog entered.
- Entries not on Official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees.
- No refund for duplicate entries or for any other cause beyond the control of PBCA will be made after the closing date.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whomever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to the entry form must be received in writing prior to the closing date.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The treasurer will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. All fees must be submitted in US funds.
- After the closing date, no entries can be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of PBCA it is impossible to open or complete the Test/Trial classes, no refund will be made.
- PBCA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have claim or recourse against PBCA or any official thereof.
- Please clean up after your dog at the site and hotel.

DIRECTIONS TO SIPES ORCHARD HOME 4431 County Home Road, Conover, NC

From I-40 in Hickory take Exit 130. Turn right at bottom of exit ramp onto West 1st Street (NC 1007) and continue to Herman Sipes Road (0.4 mile at 2nd traffic light if exiting from I-40 West or 0.6 mile at 3rd traffic light if exiting from I-40 East). Turn right on Herman Sipes Road (NC1490) and continue 2.5 miles to intersection of County Home Road (NC 1484). Turn left on County Home Road and continue 0.2 mile to entrance of Sipes Orchard Home on left. From entrance continue straight to the basketball court and then bear right onto the dirt road that leads to the barn area.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline" and the "Regulations for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be abused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.
