ENTRIES ACCEPTED. Entries close February 3, 2025 at 5:00 PM.

- A separate form must be submitted for each dog entered.
- Entries not on Official AKC entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees.
- No refund for duplicate entries or for any other cause beyond the control of PBCA will be made after the closing date.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whomever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to the entry form must be received in writing prior to the closing date.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The treasurer will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. All fees must be submitted in US funds.
- After the closing date, no entries can be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of PBCA it is impossible to open or complete the Test/Trial classes, no refund will be made.
- PBCA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have claim or recourse against PBCA or any official thereof.
- Please clean up after your dog at the site and hotel.

Ribbons will be awarded for first through fifth in each class provided that each placing results from a qualifying run. Ribbons will also be awarded for each qualifying score. All prizes and awards must be picked up at the trial. They will not be mailed.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be abused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.
