EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

SHOW HOURS are 7:30 am to 7:00 pm both days. Judging will begin at 8:30 am on Saturday and 8:30 am on Sunday.

LUNCH BREAK of 45 minutes will be scheduled at the judge's discretion.

FOOD for EXHIBITORS will be available for purchase each day.

SPACE FOR INDOOR CRATING IS LIMITED. No unentered dogs are allowed in the building.

ENTRIES:

- **ENTRIES CLOSE** Wednesday, May 15, 2019 at 5 pm.
- After the closing date, no entries can be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of PBCA it is impossible to open or complete the Trial classes, no refund will be made.
- A separate form on official AKC entry forms must be submitted for each dog entered. Entry forms or photocopies without the agreement and rules are unacceptable.

- Entries will not be accepted without fees and signature. No refund for duplicate entries or for any other cause beyond the control of PBCA will be made after the closing date. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date. Changes, additions, or corrections to the entry form must be received in writing prior to the closing date. Move ups are permitted in accordance with Obedience/Rally Regulations Ch.1 Sec. 16.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The treasurer will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. All fees must be submitted in US funds.
- PBCA may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have claim or recourse against PBCA or any official thereof.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Bitches in season will not be admitted to the trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season on the trial date will be refunded the entry fee, less \$5.00 each trial date, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification must be in the hands of the trial secretary no later than 30 minutes prior to the start time on the date of the trial.

JUMP HEIGHTS and ORDER OF JUDGING:

- Obedience Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3: A club may arrange entries according to jump height in all classes in which jumps are used. If a club should choose this option, it will be stated in the premium list what jump height will begin the class and if the order will be ascending or descending. Handlers with multiple entries in the same jump height should be accommodated.
- On Saturday judging within classes will be in order of ascending jump heights.
- On Sunday judging within classes will be in order of descending jump heights.
- **Include jump height on entry form with obedience class.** Entries without jump height will be judged at the end of the class.

Refer to the Obedience Regulations – Chapter 1, Section 16a.

- The club will clearly state in its premium list whether transfers will or will not be allowed. If no statement is provided in the premium list the default is to allow transfers.
- After a dog earns a title, it may be transferred to another class in a future trial, even though the closing date for the trial has passed, provided the club offers transfers.
- A transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class; or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records the handler and the dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.
- The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.
- Movement between an "A" and "B" class at the same level is not considered a transfer – refer to Chapter 1, Section 16B.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the afore-mentioned parties, and any AKC approved judge judging at this event, harmless from any claim or loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. - (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 inches over 13 inches but not exceeding 15 inches). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (for complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3)
